John Knox's Liturgy of 1560

Leader: We have left undone those things which we ought to have done; And we have done those things which we ought not to have done;

All: And there is no health in us. O Lord, have mercy upon us, miserable offenders.

Leader: Spare those, O God, who confess their faults. Restore those who are penitent; according to Your promises declared unto mankind in Christ Jesus our Lord.

All: And grant, O merciful Father, for His sake; that we may hereafter live a godly, righteous, and sober life; to the glory of Your son's Holy name, Amen.
