Leader: Come all the ends of the earth. Remember and turn to the Lord, and let all the families of the nations worship before you.


All: For this we come, O Lord, from among the nations, to sing to your name. That all the ends of the earth remember and turn to the Lord and that all the families of the nations worship before you.

You hold me by my right hand. You guide me with your counsel. Ps. 73:23, 24




Question: What do we pray for in the first petition?

Our days on the earth are like a shadow, and there is no abiding. <sup>16</sup> O LORD our God, all this abundance that we have provided for building you a house for your holy name comes from your hand and is all your own. <sup>17</sup> I know, my God, that you test the heart and have pleasure in uprightness. In the uprightness of my heart I have freely offered all these things, and now I have seen your people, who are present here, offering freely and joyously to you. <sup>18</sup> O LORD, the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, our fathers, keep forever such purposes and thoughts in the hearts of your people, and direct their hearts toward you. <sup>19</sup> Grant to Solomon my son a whole heart that he may keep your commandments, your testimonies, and your statutes, performing all, and that he may build the palace for which I have made provision."
