





CONFESSION OF FAITH: Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 8

24 Q. How are these articles divided?

24 A. Into three parts: God the Father and our creation; God the Son and our deliverance; and God the Holy Spirit and our sanctification.

25 Q. Since there is only one divine being, why do you speak of three: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit?






