CONFESSION OF FAITH: Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 16

40 Q. Why did Christ have to suffer death?

40 A. Because God's justice and truth require it: nothing else could pay for our sins except the death of the Son of God.

41 Q. Why was he "buried"?

41 A. His burial testifies that he really died.

42 Q. Since Christ has died for us, why do we still have to die?

42 A. Our death does not pay the debt of our sins. Rather, it puts an end to our sinning and is our entrance into eternal life.


