44 Q. Why does the creed add, "He descended to hell"?

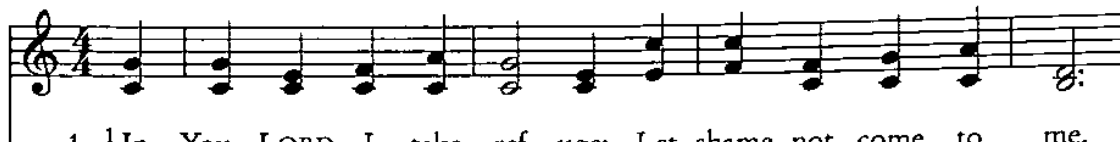
