CONFESSION OF FAITH: Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 23

59 Q. How, though, does it help you now that you believe all this?

59 A. Now, in Christ, I am righteous before God, and an heir of everlasting life.

60 Q. How are you righteous before God now that you believe all this?

60 A. Only by true faith in Jesus Christ: That is, although my conscience accuses me that I have grievously sinned against all God's commandments and never kept any of them, and that I still am always inclined to all evil, nevertheless God, without any merit of mine, out of sheer grace, grants and credits to me the perfect satisfaction, righteousness, and holiness of Christ, as if I had never sinned nor been a sinner, as if I had been perfectly obedient as Christ was obedient for me, if only I accept this gift with a believing heart.

61 Q. Why do you say that you are righteous by faith alone?

61 A. Not because God accepts me for the worthiness of my faith. Rather, only Christ's satisfaction, righteousness and holiness make me righteous before God, and I can receive this righteousness and make it mine in no other way than by faith alone.






