**CONFESSION OF FAITH: Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 24**

62 Q. But why can't the good we do make us righteous before God, or at least help in this?

**62 A. Because the righteousness which can stand before God's seat of judgement must be entirely perfect and fully meet the measure of God's law; but even the best we do in this life is imperfect and stained with sin.**

63 Q. What? How can you say that our good works earn nothing when God promises to reward them in this life and the next?

**63 A. This reward is not earned: it is a gift of grace.**

64 Q. But doesn't this teaching make people wicked, and careless about sin?

**64 A. No: it is impossible that those grafted into Christ by true faith should not produce fruits of true gratitude.**
