CONFESSION OF FAITH: Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 26

69 Q. How does baptism show you and assure you that Christ's one sacrifice on the cross is for you personally?

69 A. In this way that Christ has appointed this outward washing and added the promise that as surely as water washes away filth from my body, so certainly his blood and Spirit wash away my soul's uncleanness; that is, all my sins.

70 Q. What does it mean to be washed with Christ's blood and Spirit?

70 A. To be washed with Christ's blood means that God, through grace, has forgiven our sins for the sake of Christ's blood poured out for us in his sacrifice on the cross. To be washed with Christ's Spirit means that the Holy Spirit has renewed us and set us apart to be members of Christ so that more and more we may die to sin and live holy, blameless lives.

71 Q. Where has Christ promised that he will wash us with his blood and Spirit as surely as we are washed with the waters of baptism?

71 A. In the institution of Baptism, where he says, Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations: baptise them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. And, Whoever believes and is baptised will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. This promise is also repeated when Scripture calls baptism the washing of rebirth and the washing away of sins.
