



## CONFESSION OF FAITH: Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 25

65 Q. Since, then, we share in Christ and all his blessings by faith alone, where does this faith come from?

**65 A. From the Holy Spirit, who creates it in our hearts by the preaching of the holy gospel, and confirms us in it by the use of the holy sacraments.**

66 Q. What are the sacraments?

**66 A. Sacraments are visible, holy signs and seals appointed by God. They were appointed so that by their use God might more fully declare and make certain to us the promise of the gospel: that is, that God, by grace alone, because of Christ's one sacrifice accomplished on the cross, forgives our sins and grants to us eternal life.**

67 Q. Are both these, then, the Word and the sacraments, meant to fix our faith on the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross as the only ground of our salvation?

**67 A. Yes, indeed: for the Holy Spirit teaches us in the gospel and assures us through the holy sacraments, that our entire salvation rests on Christ's one sacrifice for us on the cross.**

68 Q. How many sacraments has Christ appointed in the New Testament?

**68 A. Two: Baptism and the Lord's Supper.**
