## **CONFESSION OF FAITH: Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 32**

86 Q. Since, then, we are delivered from our misery by grace alone through Christ without any merit of our own, why must we still do good?

**86 A. Christ has indeed redeemed us by his blood. But we also do good because Christ is also renewing us by his Spirit to be like himself, so that we, in all parts of our life, may show we are thankful to God for all he\* has done for us, and so that he may be praised through us. And we do good also so that we may be assured of our faith by its fruits, and so that our neighbors, too, may be won to Christ by our godly living.**

87 Q. Can those, then, be saved who do not turn to God from their unthankful and impenitent ways?

**87 A. By no means. For, as the Scripture says, no unchaste person, no idolater, adulterer, thief, no covetous person, no drunkard, slanderer, robber, or any such one will inherit the kingdom of God.**

*When communion is observed, please note that the outer ring of the plate contains grape juice, and the inner rings contain wine. These elements commemorate the blood of Christ.*


