

- 88 Q. What takes place in true repentance or conversion?
- 88 A. Two things take place: the dying of the old self, and the coming to life of the new.
- 89 Q. What is the dying of the old self?
- 89 A. Heartfelt sorrow for sin, causing us constantly, more and more, to hate sin and flee from it.
- 90 Q. What is the coming to life of the new self?
- 90 A. Heartfelt joy, through Christ, in God, and a delight to do every kind of good as God wants us to do.

91 Q. But what are good works?

91 A. Good works are only those which arise from true faith, conform to God's law, and are done for God's glory: they are not those which rest on our own opinion or on human commandments.
