CONFESSION OF FAITH: Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 29

78 Q. Are the bread and wine changed into the real body and blood of Christ?

78 A. No: just as the water of baptism is not changed into Christ's blood and does not itself wash away sins but is simply God's sign and assurance of this, so too the bread of the Lord's Supper is not changed into the actual body of Christ; even though it is called the body of Christ in keeping with the nature and customary language of sacraments.

79 Q. Why then does Christ call the bread his body, and the cup his blood or the new covenant in his blood; while Paul speaks of a participation in Christ's body and blood?

79 A. Christ speaks this way with good reason: firstly, to teach us by these words that as bread and wine nourish our present life, so too his crucified body and shed blood truly nourish our souls for eternal life; but also, much more, to assure us by this visible sign and pledge, that we share in his true body and blood, through the Holy Spirit's work, just as truly as our mouths receive these holy signs in his remembrance, and that all of his suffering and obedience are ours just as surely as if we ourselves had suffered and paid for our sins.


