THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

92 Q. What does the Lord say in his Law?

92 A. God spoke all these words: "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery."

The First Commandment

"You shall have no other gods before me."

The Second Commandment

“You shall not make for yourself a carved image in the form of anything in heaven above, or on earth beneath, or in the waters under the earth. You shall not bow down to these or serve them; for I, the LORD* your God, allow no unfaithfulness, punishing the children to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing steadfast love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.”

“You shall not use the name of the LORD your God for evil purposes, for the LORD will not hold guiltless anyone who misuses his name.”
