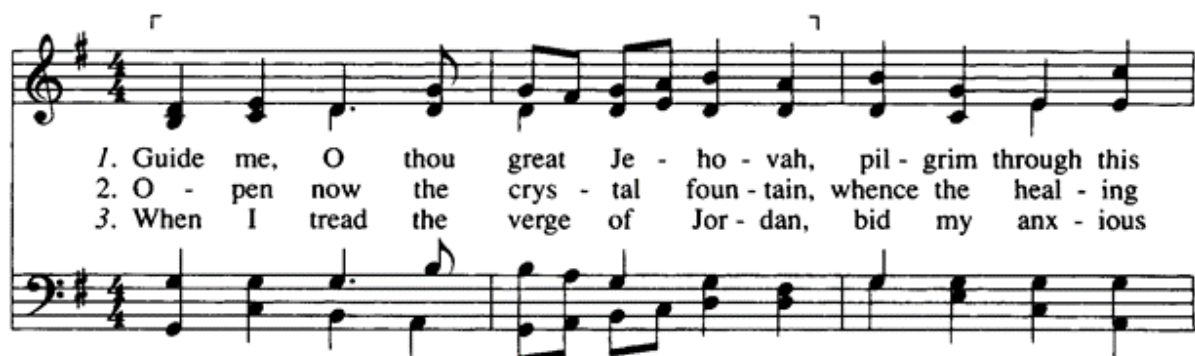
**COMMUNION**

and the inner rings contain wine. These elements commemorate the blood of Christ.*

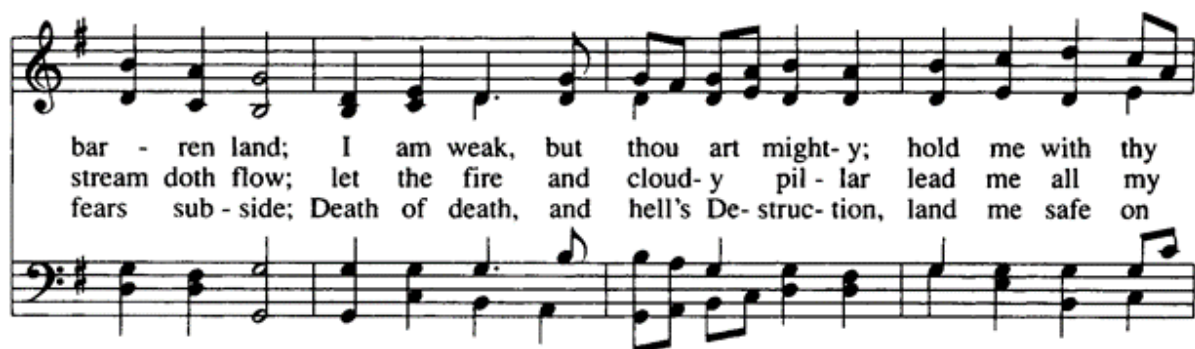

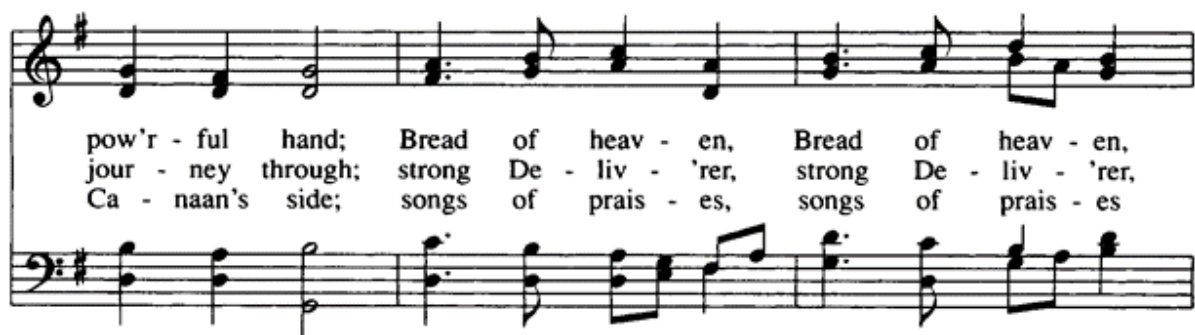
