**CATECHISM – To Be A Christian**

Q. 36. Who is God?

**A. 36. God is one divine Being eternally existing in three divine Persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This is the Holy Trinity.**

Q. 38. Who is God the Father?

**A. 38. God the Father is the first Person of the Trinity, from whom the Son is eternally begotten and the Holy Spirit eternally proceeds.**

Q. 48. Who is Jesus Christ?

**A. 48. Jesus Christ is the eternal Word and Son of God, the second Person of the Holy Trinity. He took on human nature to be the Savior and Redeemer of the world, the only Mediator between God and fallen humanity.**

Q. 84. Who is the Holy Spirit?

**A. 84. God the Holy Spirit is the third Person in the one Being of the Holy Trinity, coequal and coeternal with God the Father and God the Son, and equally worthy of our honor and worship.**
